

## Wireless Computer Access for Guests

The University of Houston System at Sugar Land provides guests the ability to connect wirelessly to the Internet from any room or area in the George and Brazos Hall Buildings. To configure your laptop for wireless access, please follow these steps. (Note: These steps are based on the Windows operating system. If you use the Macintosh operating system, the steps are similar but the specific screens and box names may be different.)

1. Start up your laptop.
2. Find the "Wireless Network Connection" icon in your system tray at the bottom right of your screen. Double click on the icon. A "Choose A Wireless Network" screen will appear.
3. Find the wireless network labeled "**UHWireless**". Click on that network and then click the "Connect" button.

**Note:** If you have stringent security settings on your computer, you may get a notice stating that the network you are connecting to is unsecure. You can either change your computer's security settings or simply press the "Connect anyway" button.

4. When you click "Connect", your computer will search for the wireless network and attempt to connect. When it finds that network, you will see "Connected" in the box. When you see that you are connected, click the "X" in the top right corner and exit the screen.
5. Open your web browser. A welcome screen will appear with a "User Login" box. Type **UHGuest** in the User name box and **UHGuest** in the password box. **Type in UHGuest exactly as written in the password box as it is case sensitive.** After you have typed in the password, click the "Logon" button.

**Note:** If you have a popup blocker enabled, you may receive an error message when you press the "Logon" button. If you do, simply click on the button for your browser home page or type in the web address you want and the page will load.

6. If you log in successfully, your web browser's home page will appear.
7. If you have problems with any step in this process or want assistance when you first try to connect to the wireless network, contact the technical staff at the Help Desk.
